Ecology Action is staffed by a team of experts in energy efficiency, toxics reduction, community recycling, business waste reduction, water quality protection, water conservation, sustainable transportation, renewable energy systems design, program design, environmental education, stakeholder engagement, environmental policy, communications, research and management.

Community partnerships are at the core of Ecology Action's success. Every program and initiative is made possible through collaborative relationships with visionary business leaders, local and regional government agencies, other nonprofits and committed community members.

ECOLOGY ACTION'S PROGRAMS HAVE

- Delivered over 245,000,000 kilowatt-hours of annual energy savings, resulting in over \$36,000,000 in cost savings for program participants.
- Eliminated approximately 83,000 tons of CO₂ per year, equivalent to taking 25,039 cars off the road or planting 39,472 acres of trees.
- Helped local residents and events recycle at a rate equivalent to three cans per minute per person.
- Assisted livestock owners to keep over 1.5 million pounds of manure out of local waterways annually.
- Saved schools over \$500,000 over the past decade, by keeping 7.5 tons of waste out of landfills.
- Reduced over 1,000,000 vehicle miles traveled.
- Helped contractors and property owners statewide to reduce energy use through the Energy Upgrade California program.

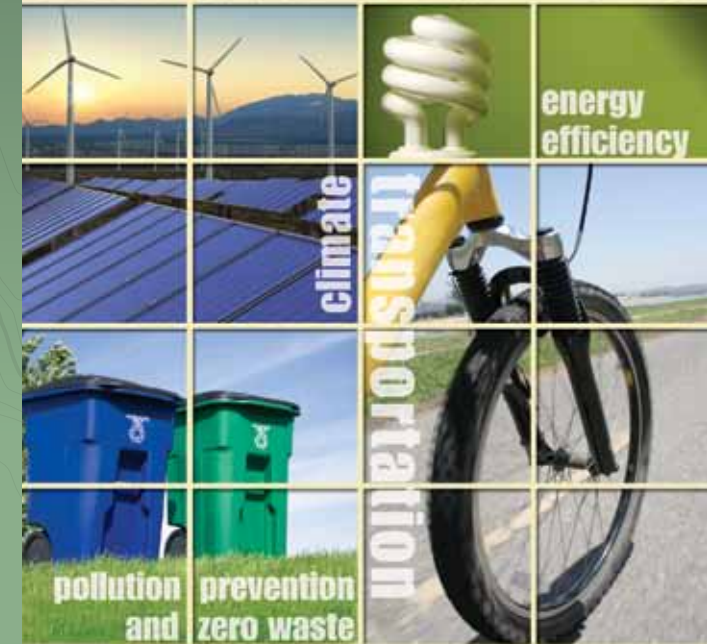
